BRAEMAR STONE

Competitor will get three attempts to put the stone. The farthest put will be scored.

LW, MW, HW, MASTER 22#

WOMEN 16#

WEIGHT FOR DISTANCE

Competitor will get three attempts to throw the implement. The farthest throw will be scored.

LW, MW, HW, MASTER 28#

WOMEN 16#

WEIGHT FOR HEIGHT

Competitor will get three attempts at each height attempted to throw the implement over the bar. The highest throw over the bar will be scored.

LW, MW, HW, MASTER 56#

WOMEN 28#

FARMERS WALK

One attempt, for time.

Standard farmers implements with 1 ¼" un-knurled handles set at 18" high.

Time starts when both implements are locked out, time stops when one and/or both implements hit the floor. Equipment allowed: belt, chalk, wrist wraps, knee wraps or sleeves.

LW / Masters – 185 each hand 370 total

MWD - 200 each hand 400 total

HWD – 250 each hand 500 total

2" AXLE CLEAN AND PRESS FOR REPS

One attempt, for time.

Standard Axle implements with Tires.

Implement must be lifted by any means to chest and pressed for reps arms and legs must be locked out. Equipment allowed: belt, chalk, wrist wraps, knee wraps or sleeves.

LW / Masters– 185

MWD - 200

HWD – 220

HUSAFELL STONE

One attempt, for time. Time will start when athlete is ready stone will be picked from the platform and carried for distance. Equipment allowed: belt, chalk, wrist wraps, knee & elbow wraps and sleeves

LW / Masters – 300

MWD – 300

HWD – 300
